
Whether you are from an urban or rural hometown, SUNY Sullivan offers a sense of adventure and a sense of belonging.

A typical SUNY Sullivan student? There is no such thing. Our learning community is as diverse as our academic offerings. And it's growing!





Presidential Scholars Program

First introduced in 2012, SUNY Sullivan's Presidential Scholars program makes a college education more accessible and more affordable for high-achieving students graduating from Sullivan County high schools.

Students with a minimum overall grade average of 90 are eligible to receive the scholarship.



The Presidential Scholars program funds up to full tuition and fees for two years at SUNY Sullivan.


